

this fund raiser are used to support Right to Life. We will be selling the roses for \$3 each or 2 for \$5. Treat your special someone to a rose or two.


Baptismal Preparation Class

- 4. Reviews the annual parish budget with the Pastor/Administrator/ Pastoral Leader.
- 5. With the Pastor/Administrator/Pastoral Leader, reviews and signs the annual financial report to the diocese.
