Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office anytime.

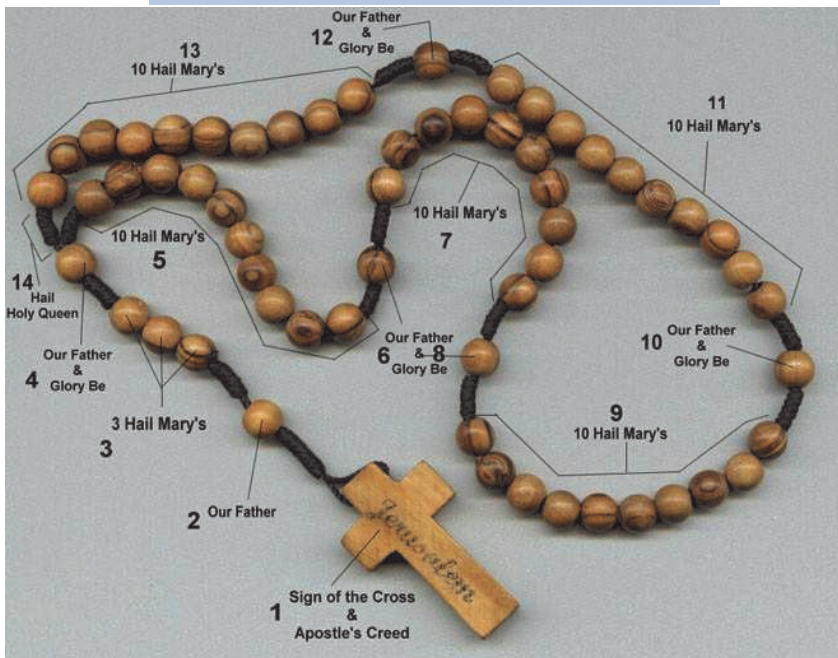
Fr. Jim's Jottings
