

On Monday, the whole country stopped for 3 minutes to witness the solar eclipse. People traveled across the country to obtain the best viewing spots. They camped out overnight waiting for that 3-minute experience. The Trading on Wall Street and the Stock Exchange slowed to a halt as employees ran out of offices donning their safety glasses to catch a glimpse of the event.
