

As you know, it is a bill and we will have to pay even if we don't make our goal but it would be a nice shot in the arm to reach our goal. That's it...no more money talk!

Lastly, there are many bicycle riders in the parish. Like the blessing of the ships or the blessing of the animals, we will have the blessing of the bikes after the 4pm Mass on May 4th. Please ride your bike to church or bring it in your car or come without it and we will bless all our riders even if you don't bring your bike! Let's always find reasons to celebrate our lives. Promise to be more inspiring next week.
