

Happy Pentecost! We complete our Easter season with the feast of Pentecost, and we cry out to the Spirit to renew us and refresh us. The power of the Spirit is sometimes overlooked or underestimated. When the Spirit is not alive in our lives, it's usually because we are trying to control the Spirit. It's easier to live lukewarm lives than being open to the power of the Spirit. The Spirit will never allow us to be lukewarm but calls us to be passionate, bold, courageous, compassionate and extravagant with our love! It is that power that we celebrate today.
