# **Br. Ray's Reflections**


I will be away this week. I can hear the cries or is that applause?? I'm going to visit some of my family in Florida. I suspect my timing may be off as the weather will probably be a balmy 110 degrees in the shade! I always get the months wrong! This weekend we are blessed to have Fr. Celestine at our Masses to speak about the missions. Envelopes for the collection will be in the back of church. Please welcome him with the great St. Joe's spirit.

In today's Gospel, we have the disciples in the boat with Jesus and the violent storm comes up and terrifies them. According to the account in Mark's gospel, Jesus appears to be sleeping through the storm. I suspect all of us have felt that distress as we went through a trying storm, and felt God was nowhere to be found. "Where are you, God? Don't you care that we're going through this terrible moment in our lives?" We think of those moments of grief when we've lost one we've loved or times of illness when the diagnosis was terrifying or those moments of transition when we were fearful that our lives would never settle down, again. You can fill in the moments that you have felt like the disciples and wondered where Christ was to comfort you. The response of Jesus after he stilled the waters is "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" Maybe that's what Jesus says to us when we fret and worry about so many things. He reminds us today that he is in the boat with us and although the situation may not make any sense to us, he is still in control. Let's keep reminding ourselves that Christ is always there and, although he may not calm the storms when we want it, he will be there to bring peace and comfort to our hearts and will still the storm in his time. Storms don't last forever, and the brightness of the sun will be seen again. If we keep that perspective, we can get through anything. Just remember whatever you're going through... GOD'S GOT THIS SO WE'VE GOT THIS! Have a great week!
