REACHING IN, REACHING OUT, REACHING GOD

Br. Ray's Reflections

I have been overwhelmed by the images that have come out of Maui this week. The people of Lahaina, although completely heartbroken over the suffering that has come to their people and their land, refuse to allow it to destroy their beautiful spirit. Reporters have interviewed residents who ran from the flames with only the clothes on their back and yet they continue to be grateful for life. They have also been a witness of faith. The news showed a group gathered for Sunday Mass in a nearby church. When parishioners who had lost homes and family members in the fire were interviewed, they spoke about God's grace and their faith getting them through this tragedy. Many who lost everything continue to help others in the community. No tragic events are ever welcomed, but when seen with the eyes of faith one begins to witness the light of the Divine in the compassion and love of those who survive. We are seeing the Kingdom of God on the island of Maui. One person said, "Our 'Aloha' way is to be community to one another and with this terrible tragedy, our community has only gotten stronger." May we all learn from the community of Maui.

Since hearing this news, I was wondering how we can help our brothers and sisters in Maui. I thought we can take up a collection and send it to Catholic Relief Services but that seems somewhat impersonal. Then, this morning a parishioner called with an idea. She said she has a friend in the neighboring parish to Lahaina and thought if we were to send our contributions to the parish, they could use it to help with direct needs in a quicker manner than larger agencies. The neighboring parish is St. Anthony of Padua in Wailuku. From what I understand, they are already assisting people from Lahaina and our contributions could be very helpful in the immediate future. We will take up a collection after all the Masses for the next 2 weeks and send St. Anthony's a check or, if you wish, you can go right to the St. Anthony website and make a donation online for the Maui Relief Fund. In the memo/note area, you may want to let them know you are sending the contribution with prayers from St. Joe's Parish in Appleton. Let's do what we can to help our brothers and sisters in Maui.
