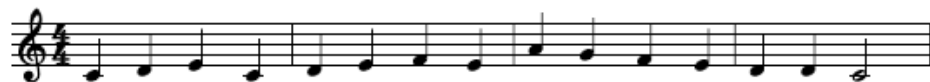

## Sing, My Tongue, the Savior's Glory

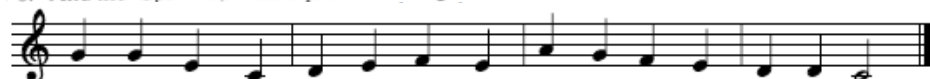
ST. THOMAS (TANTUM ERGO)

6. And the Spir-it, God pro-ceed-ing From them Each e-ter-nal-ly,



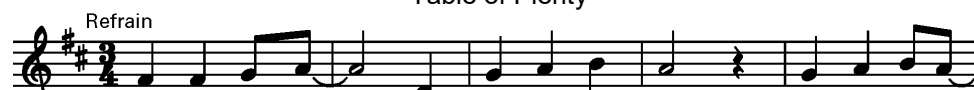
1. Des-tined for the world's re-demp-tion, From a no-ble womb to spring.

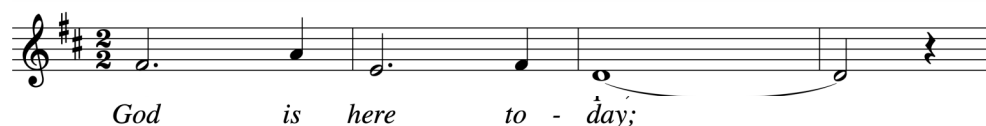

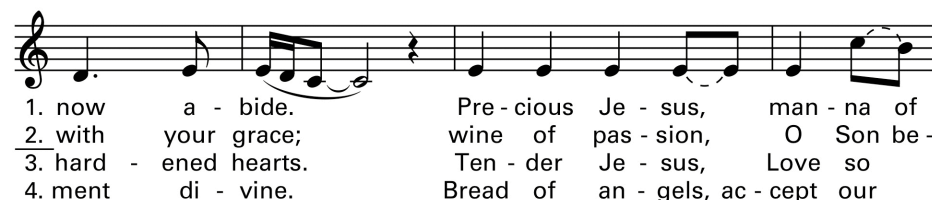
